Can you help a friend? Classroom lesson KS2

Introducing this lesson to your pupils.

Explain to your pupils that in the next 30 minutes they are going to be taking part in a role-play exercise and take on the role of a 13 year old girl called Jessica Samara. Jessica is a friend of Tiffany Walker also 13. Tiffany has moved away from the area and her father bought her a computer and a mobile telephone to enable her to keep in touch with her friends. Tiffany has had several contacts in a chat room, by e-mail and text from a person she does not know. She is not sure how to deal with this and keeps sending you e-mails messages asking for your advice – after all you are her old best friend!

The messages your teacher will give you are all from Tiffany. Read what Tiffany is up to and then answer the questions she poses. This is not a race or competition, the important thing is that you think about the issues

Can you help a friend?

INTRODUCTION

You are 13 years of age and you go to school at Wimbledon Middle School. Last term your best friend Tiffany Walker left Wimbledon with her father to live in Huntingbridge where Mr Walker started a new job.

Mr Walker bought Tiffany her own computer so that she could use it to keep in contact with some of her old friends. Tiffany has kept in touch using e-mail and chat and has been telling you all about the new life she has in Huntingbridge.

Questions for you.

What are the good things about being able to use a computer to keep in touch with friends? Are there any downsides?

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MESSAGE number 1



To Jess from Tiff

“Hi Jess! I don’t like my new school, I have not made any new friends and I want to move back to Wimbledon, dad has said that it is not possible. I have been getting messages from someone called Leon. I suppose he’s a boy. He seems really nice and he likes the same bands as I do. He has told me he is 16 years old and used to go to my old school – isn’t that funny?

I’ve never chatted to anybody in a chat room before what do you think I should ask them ?”

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MESSAGE number 2



To Jess from Tiff

“Hi Jess, Guess what! I got a message from someone called Leon last night. He said he had been chucked out of school, but he didn’t like it anyway. He said he could meet me and we could spend the day in Wimbledon. I said my dad would not let me do that, but Leon said I should not bother letting dad know.

What do, you think? Should I meet him? Should I tell my dad? ”

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MESSAGE NUMBER 3.



To Jess from Tiff

“Hi Jess! Leon sent me his picture by e-mail! He looks like a film star! My dad would not let me meet him, and it is a good job dad doesn’t come anywhere my computer because I’ve got it up in my bedroom.

I was told never to accept e-mail attachments because they may contain viruses but this one came from someone I know so it’s OK isn’t it ? Have you ever been sent a photo by e-mail ? What should I do ?”

To Jess from Tiff

Hi Jess! We meet in this chat room, some of the things he says I do not really understand.

Have you ever used a chat room, great aren't they, good job parents don't know about them?

Have you ever talked about chat rooms with your mum or dad ?***

To Jess from Tiff

Hi Jess! My dad bought me my own mobile phone , Leon says I should give him the number so he can text me, he says it will be easier and he can reach me anytime even in school!

Do you think I should give Leon my mobile number? Who do you give your mobile phone number to?

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MESSAGE NUMBER 6



To Jess from Tiff

“Hi Jess! Leon sent me an e-mail, he said that I had not been in the chat room and that he was cross because he wanted to talk to me. He doesn’t seem to know that I have got other things to do, dad made me do some of the housework this evening.

Leon doesn’t understand, he said that if I did not do what he said he would tell my dad what I have been doing. If he tells my dad I will be in big trouble, he doesn’t know I’ve been talking to Leon.

How does Leon knows where I live, I don’t think I told him. What should I do ? Should I tell a teacher or my dad ?

Do you think I should tell my teacher that he is bothering me? I wish I hadn’t given him my mobile – have you ever been in a situation like this?”

I’ve not gone back to that chat room and will only use moderated rooms from now on and not give any personal information away.
